Position Summary:

The basic function of the Service Technician is to provide installation and service to pumps and water treatment systems, well disinfection and well cleaning. The technician will handle customer service calls, make recommendations for equipment replacement, upgrades and service agreements. In addition, the technician will handle service and installations to commercial clients and EOCP customers.

Key Duties:

- Perform basic mechanical and electrical labor on pumps and electrical controls as well as operation of chemical disinfection systems
- Install, service and maintain submersible, jet, sewage, effluent and de-watering pumps
- Install pressure tanks, switches, control boxes, drive systems and calibrate if required
- Take water samples, perform flow testing and complete water system inspection reports
- Review job plans and visit job sites with sales person or service manager as required
- Insure service van is stocked for each job and provisions are made with purchaser for parts
- Disinfect wells and piping
- Complete daily dispatch with details of parts used, description of work performed.
- Follow company work order policies
- Collecting payment for services as required

Other Duties:

- Report to service manager with any concerns, discrepancies and recommendations for each completed job
- Insure that all work is done in compliance with Worker's Compensation Board and company safety regulations
- Communicate with dispatcher and service manager regarding work progress and any issues that may impact the job or other jobs for the day/week

- Be available as the on-call technician for after-hours work as required
- Work out of town as required
- Maintain a clean, organized van and communicate any deficiencies mechanical or otherwise to service manager
- Interact with customers to ensure good customer service
- Make recommendations to customers for upgrades, replacements and service agreements
- Work with all departments to meet company goals and objectives
- Assist in the store and warehouse
